

## GarageBand Tutorial by Serena Carpenter

### Save Project:

Save As: title that reflect your work, not you. Use lowercased letters.

Where: Student: Save to desktop or external hard drive. Create a your own folder in the Student server, and drag it to your folder.

### GarageBand Window

1. Close the piano
2. Drag .mp3 file to the window to import audio
3. Features
  - a. + = create new track
  - b. Eye = Features music and sound clips.
  - c. Scissor = edit clips
  - d. Transport controls = (red=record; circle = play over and over)
  - e. Timer: Change to timecode, not beats
  - f. Master audio volume: control volume of all tracks. Double check to see if it as the right level before exporting
4. Track Controls
  - a. Timeline
    - i. Tracks – move them. Adjust track size
    - ii. Playhead
    - iii. Mute – check master audio levels of each track
5. ADJUST Volume – fade audio Track Info Pane (I)
  - a. Labels
6. Editor
  - a. Rename clip
  - b. Zoom slider
  - c. Waveform display

### Editing Tracks

1. Timeline
  - a. Move playhead to edit point
  - b. Split tracks
  - c. Delete clip
2. Editor
  - a. Highlight section
  - b. Delete clip

### Exporting Audio

1. Save your project
2. Share
  - a. Send song to iTunes. Creates an AIFF file
  - b. Double click on it to listen
  - c. iTunes > Preferences > Advanced > Importing > MP3
  - d. Advanced > Convert to mp3
  - e. Close GarageBand
  - f. Find the music
    - i. Go to Home > Music > iTunes > iTunes Music >
