

Forwarding your ASU url using GoDaddy by Serena Carpenter

1. Sign up for your personal domain name. If you do not want to host it on ASU's space, buy hosting space as well. However, you can host it on ASU's hosting space for free. These are instructions for those who are hosting with ASU, but are buying their domain name from GoDaddy.com. So just purchase your domain name from GoDaddy. Right now it costs \$10.69 per year for your domain name. It is cheaper if you purchase it for multiple years.
2. Select Domain Manager



3. Click on your purchased domain name. It may take a few minutes for your domain name to appear.
4. Select Forwarding > Manage
